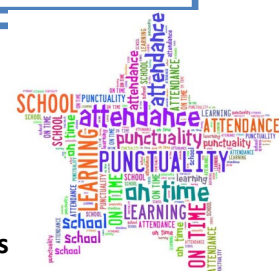


Weekly Attendance Figures
