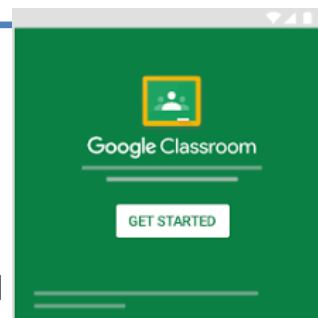

Google Classroom

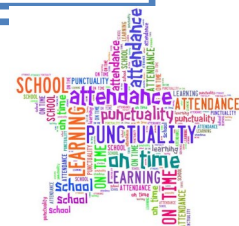
